


Construction Update for the Week of April 2

Old Town construction crews have finished the first section of water main installation between the Route 31 Bypass and Washington Street. Crews successfully prepared the water main so that it will be ready for water service connections that will begin next week. Transferring water service from the old water main to the new water main is anticipated to require a two hour shutdown of water service. Any customers in this area (between the Route 31 Bypass and Washington Street) that have concerns about when the water service work will occur should contact Dan Crosson at (847) 417-4216.

Sanitary service connections will continue to be installed throughout the week and the construction of new storm sewers will begin. We appreciate everyone's patience as we install these critical pieces of new infrastructure. The current detour remains in effect.
