



Construction Update for the Week of August 6

North of Washington Street, crews will begin the next stage of construction on the east side of Main Street by placing structural soil behind the newly installed curb. The next step will be to add the electrical conduits, underdrains, and irrigation sleeves. These infrastructure additions will ultimately be underground and out of view.

South of Washington Street, crews have officially completed the electrical conduits. The new conduits will allow the overhead utility wires to be moved underground. Moving the utility wires underground will provide unobstructed views and allow trees to grow more naturally.

Due to construction activities, the current **one-way only northbound** Main Street detour remains in effect north of Washington Street. Local northbound traffic on Main Street will use a temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to exit onto Harrison Street.
