



Construction Update for the Week of August 13

This week, the construction crews will begin the process of placing and grading the stone behind the curb in preparation for new sidewalks north of Washington Street. A concrete base with brick pavers on top will then be placed in this area. The new sidewalks will provide a smooth surface for pedestrians, replacing the cracked and uneven sidewalk that previously caused safety concerns. In addition, work continues under Main Street on the electrical conduits and irrigation piping.

People visiting Old Town businesses this week will also notice the construction of new stoops at two local businesses. Businesses on Main Street remain open as stoop installation progresses. Parking is available at the Village lot located at the corner of Harrison and Washington streets.

As a reminder, the current **one-way only northbound** Main Street detour remains in effect north of Washington Street. Local northbound traffic on Main Street will use a temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to exit onto Harrison Street.
