

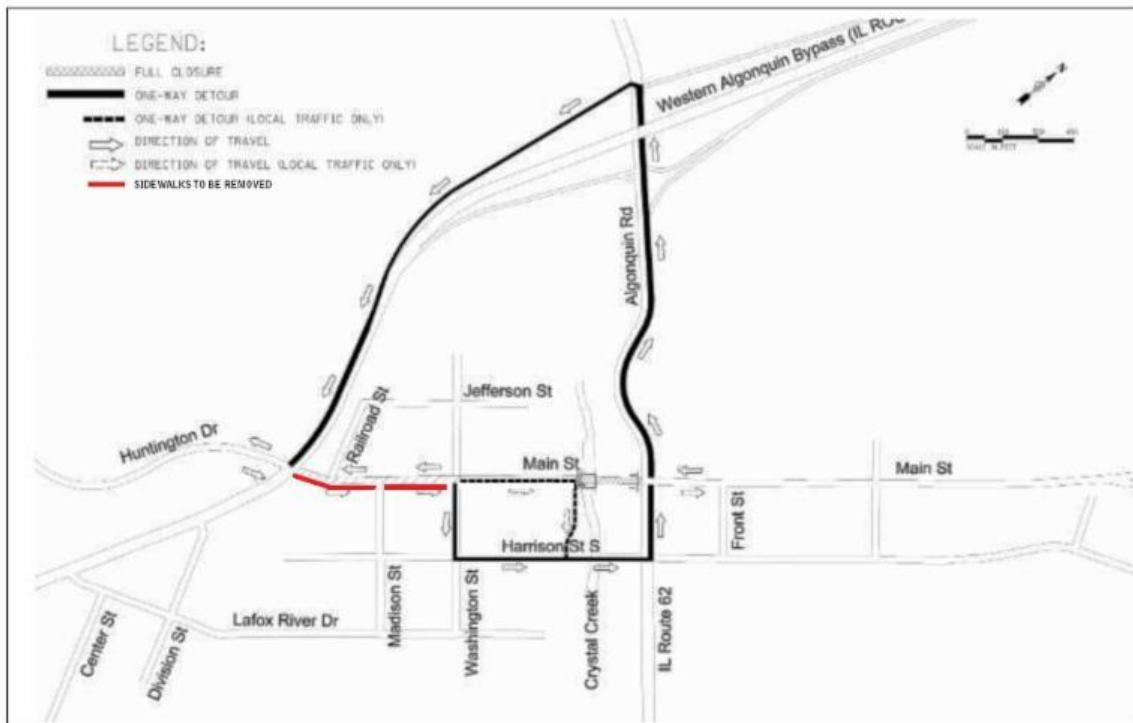
## Construction Update for the Week of August 20

In order to ensure that Old Town Algonquin is a welcoming and accessible place for all users, crews will be reconstructing building entrances north of Washington Street this week. This work will make the building entrances compliant with the American with Disabilities Act. The Village is committed to improving the safety of all pedestrians in the Old Town District.

This is a reminder that crews will also begin the sidewalk and curb removal process on the east side of Main Street between the Bypass and Washington Street on Tuesday. This work is advancing ahead of schedule as the team is adjusting construction activities.

Please be alert when driving in this area as the **northbound traffic on Main Street will be shifted to the west half of the street** to accommodate these construction activities. The current one-way only northbound Main Street detour will remain in effect north of Washington Street.

Support local businesses by visiting Old Town's distinctive shops and restaurants. Parking is available in the Village's parking lot on the corner of Harrison and Washington streets.
