

Main Street Construction to Begin

Exciting news, the warming temperatures have allowed construction to officially begin on the Old Town Algonquin project!

Beginning next week crews will start the process of moving the overhead electrical utility lines underground and replacing the water main under Main Street. In order to safely complete this work, Main Street between Washington Street and Railroad Street will be closed to thru traffic beginning Tuesday the 27th. Please follow the posted detour route.



Please note that access will be maintained for local traffic and emergency vehicles only. We anticipate this work to take approximately 3 weeks.

Next week you will also notice construction crews beginning work near N. Main Street and Front Street. These crews will be working to install the necessary infrastructure for

moving the overhead utility lines underground. There will not be any road closures associated with this work but you may encounter some minor traffic delays. Please use caution when driving through this area.
