


Construction Update for the Week of July 2

The beginning of July marks the midway point of construction in Old Town Algonquin! Visit <u>oldtownalgonquin.org</u> to view how Main Street looked prior to construction, a timelapse video of the work completed so far, and planned design features.

On Wednesday, construction will be suspended in recognition of Independence Day. Crews will resume installing the new water main on Thursday.

As a reminder, Main Street from Washington Street to Algonquin Road is currently functioning as a **one-way only southbound** street through this phase of construction. Vehicles traveling northbound on Main Street are being detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street.
