


Construction Update for the Week of July 9

A new, temporary traffic pattern on Main Street will go into effect on Monday, July 9. North of Washington Street, traffic will be **one-way only northbound on Main Street**. The temporary traffic pattern is in place to accommodate the removal and replacement of the bridge over Crystal Creek. Local northbound traffic on Main Street will need to use a temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street. Businesses should find delivery alternatives as truck traffic will not be allowed in this area.

South of Washington Street, two-way traffic will be allowed and electrical work will continue through the week.
