


Construction Update for the Week of July 23

As we reach the halfway point in the construction schedule on Main Street, crews have begun work that will improve the area for pedestrians and bicyclists. Last week, crews began sidewalk demolition on the east side of Main Street to prepare for construction of new, accessible sidewalks. Work during the week of July 23 will include the removal, excavation and preparation of the area for new curbs and gutters between Washington Street and Crystal Creek. This construction phase will continue through mid-August.

The current **one-way only northbound** Main Street detour remains in effect north of Washington Street. Local northbound traffic on Main Street will use a temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to exit onto Harrison Street.

As a reminder, businesses on Main Street remain **open during construction**. Ramps will be installed to allow access to local business entrances during construction. Parking is available in the Village's parking lot at the corner Harrison and Washington streets.
