

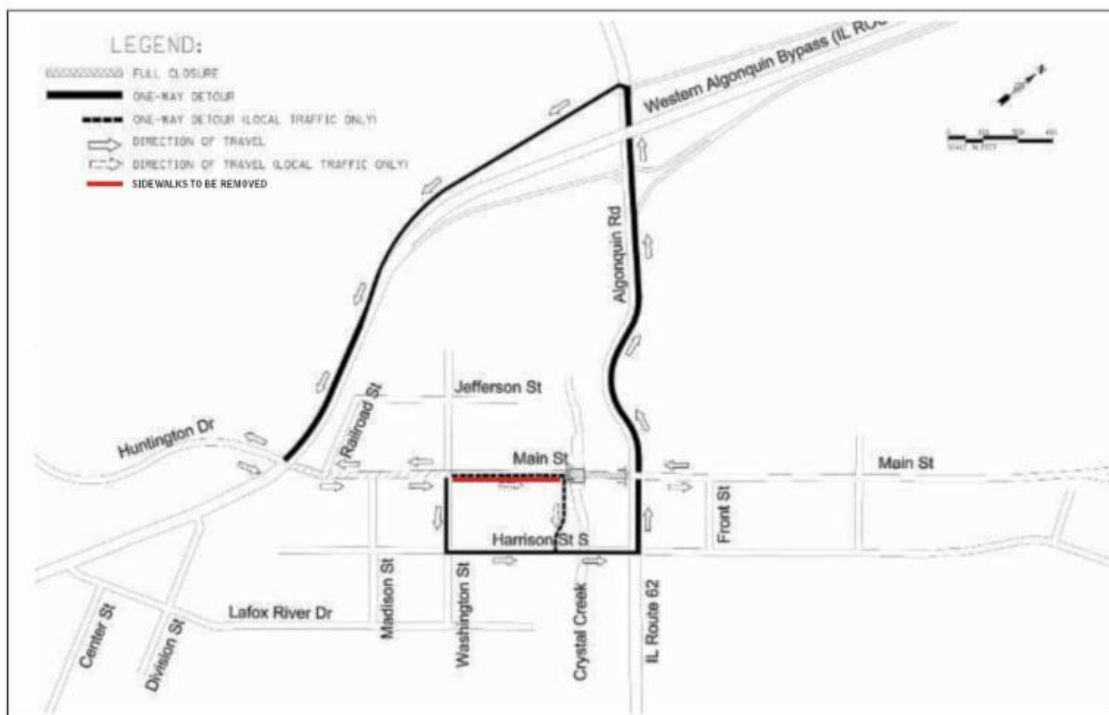


Construction Update for the Week of July 30

Beginning in the morning, Monday, July 30, construction crews will start installing new curbs and gutters on the east side of Main Street between Washington Street and Crystal Creek. This work will officially launch the visual transformation of Old Town Algonquin. We invite you to "[Take a Look](#)" and watch as this area is revitalized.

Electrical work will continue south of Washington Street through the week. As a reminder, the current **one-way only northbound** Main Street detour remains in effect north of Washington Street. Local northbound traffic on Main Street will use a temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to exit onto Harrison Street.

Don't forget to visit your favorite shop or restaurant on Main Street as businesses remain **open during construction**. Parking is available in the Village's parking lot on the corner of Harrison and Washington streets.
