


## Construction Update for the Week of June 18

Crews continue the installation of the new water main this week and our <u>time lapse</u> <u>camera</u> on the project website provides a glimpse of some of this work. Once crews complete this work, the road is patched until the construction of a new roadway on Main Street during a future phase of the project. The new roadway will give users a smooth and safe ride through Old Town.

As we prepare for the exciting future of Old Town Algonquin, we thank everyone who has been a part of Main Street's history. The Village is offering to return engraved bricks that were donated to fund the previous downtown project. People interested in reclaiming a brick they purchased through this program have until **July 31**<sup>st</sup> to submit their request. As a reminder, Main Street from Washington Street to Algonquin Road is currently functioning as a **one-way only southbound** street through this phase of construction. Vehicles traveling northbound on Main Street are being detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street.
