


Construction Update for the Week of May 21

On Monday, construction crews will begin installing the new storm sewer between Washington Street and Algonquin Road. The electrical contractor will also begin installing underground conduits or pipes near the intersection of Main Street and the Bypass.

Main Street from Washington Street north to Algonquin Road will continue to function as a **one-way only southbound** street through this phase of construction. Vehicles traveling northbound on Main Street are being detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street.

Drivers are urged to use caution while traveling in this area to ensure the safety of workers and pedestrians.
