


Construction Update for the Week of May 28

On Monday, construction will be suspended in recognition of Memorial Day. Tuesday, storm sewer work will resume between Washington Street and Algonquin Street.

Main Street from Washington Street north to Algonquin Road will continue to function as a **one-way only southbound** street through this phase of construction. Vehicles traveling northbound on Main Street are being detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street. At the end of the week, the open travel lane and parking on Main Street will be shifted to the west side of Main Street, but will remain one-way southbound.

Drivers are urged to use caution while traveling in this area to ensure the safety of workers and pedestrians.
