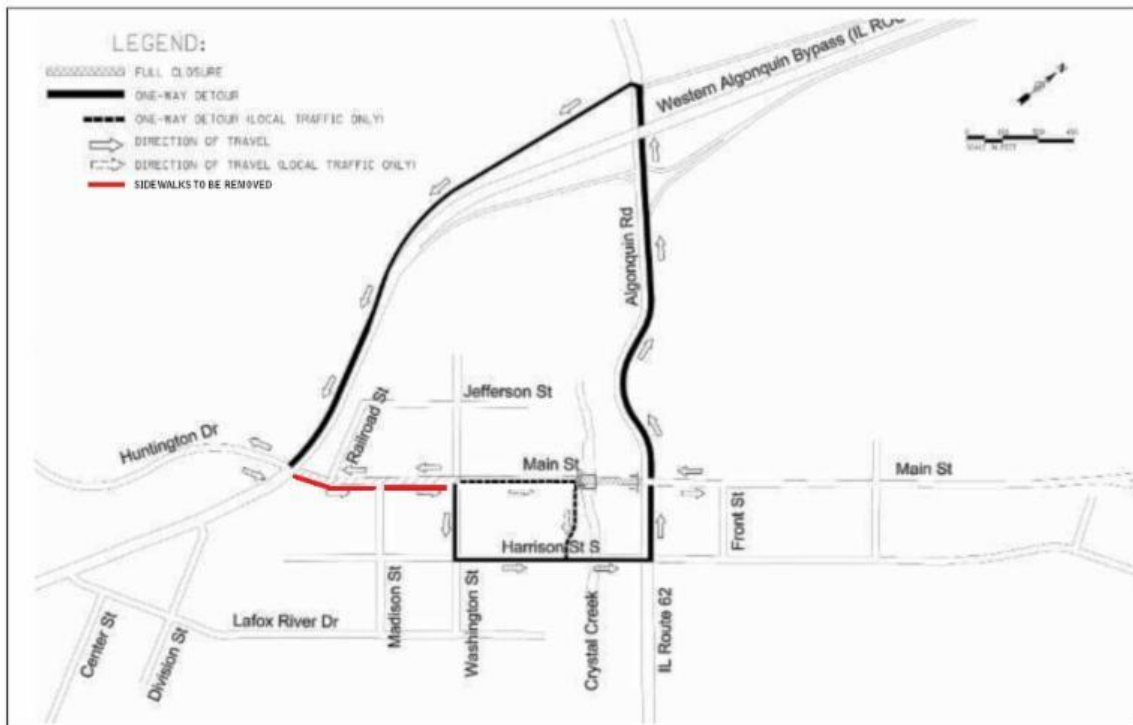


Construction Update for the Week of September 3

Construction activities will be suspended on Monday in observance of Labor Day. Crews will resume preparation work on the curbs on the east side of Main Street (south of Washington Street) on Tuesday. Weather and schedule permitting, crews may be able to begin pouring the concrete for the curb in that area before the end of the week. Crews will also begin pouring the base layer for the street on the east side of south Main Street.

The Village invites you to take a look at the progress completed so far in the transformation of Main Street into a vibrant, pedestrian friendly gather space for generations to come. Parking is available in the Village's parking lot on the corner of Harrison and Washington streets for people visiting the Old Town District.

As a reminder, northbound traffic on Main Street from the Bypass to Washington Street is shifted to the west half of the street. Northbound traffic continues one-way north of Washington Street to the temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street.
