

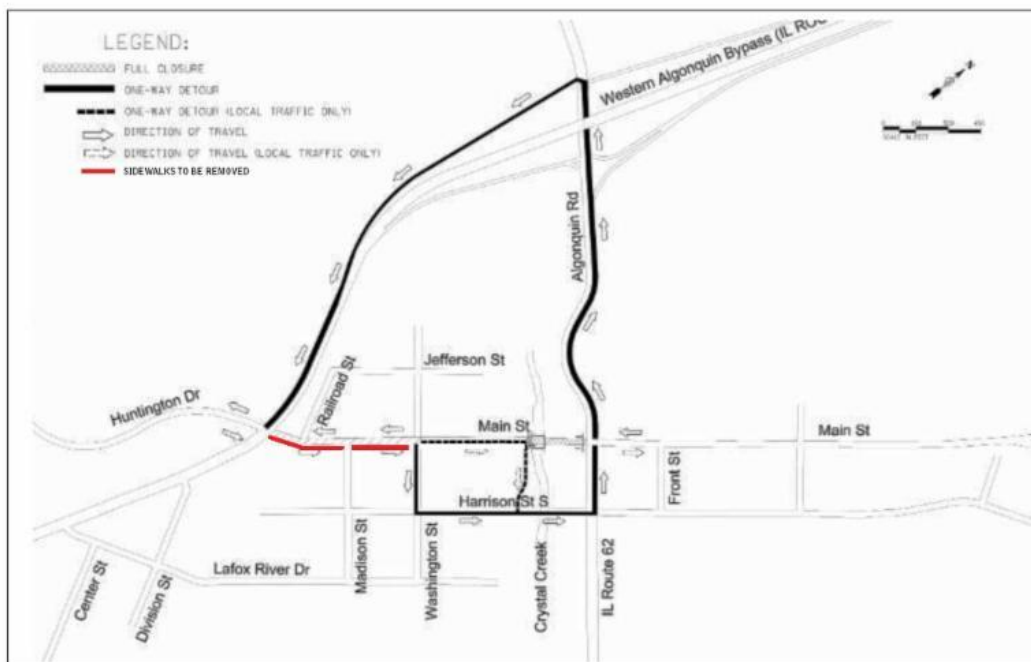


Construction Update for the Week of September 10

Construction crews continue preparing Old Town for the installation of new sidewalks on the east side of Main Street. This process includes pouring concrete this week between the Bypass and Washington Street for the sidewalk, curb and parking stalls.

Crews will also be replacing some of the business stoops on the west side of Main Street north of Washington Street. The work completed thus far has started shaping the new Old Town District. Be a part of the excitement and take a stroll on the new concrete surface while visiting the many fine shops, restaurants and businesses on Main Street.

As a reminder, northbound traffic on Main Street from the Bypass to Washington Street is shifted to the west half of the street. Northbound traffic continues one-way north of Washington Street to the temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street.
