



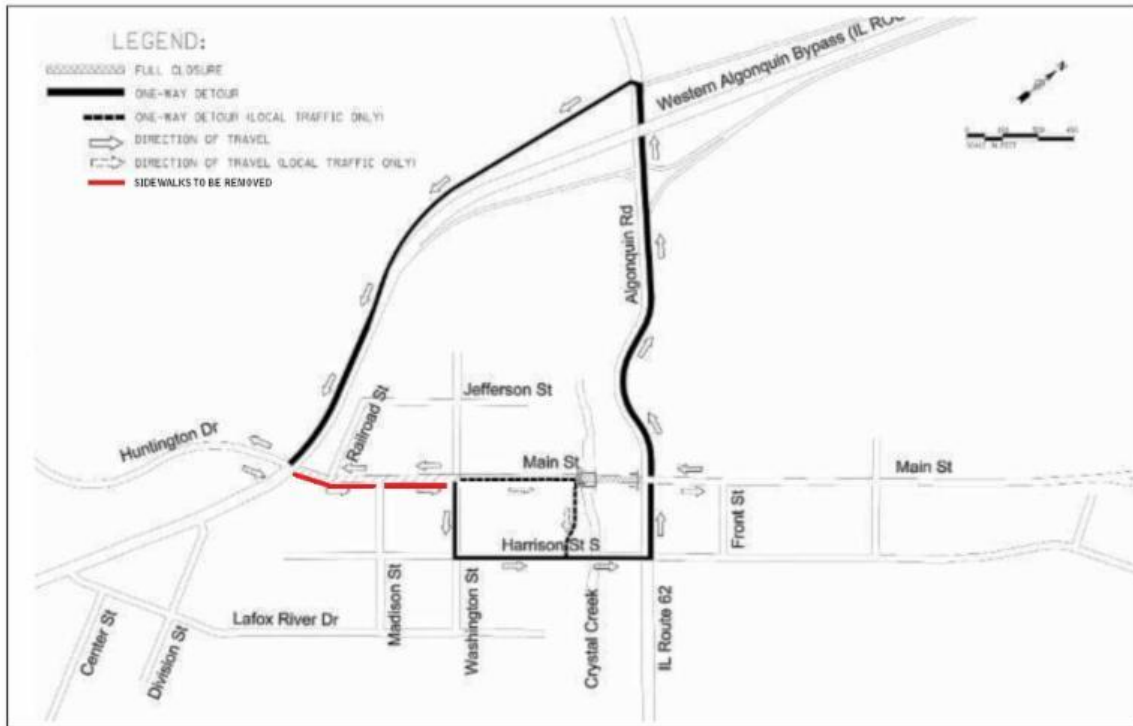
Construction Update for the Week of September 17

Construction crews continue making progress on the Old Town Algonquin improvements. The sidewalks on the east side of Main Street have begun to take shape and show a fresh look for Old Town.



This week crews will continue replacing some of the business stoops and sidewalks on Main Street. Come see the improvements first hand and do not forget to stop in to your favorite restaurants and businesses on Main Street.

As a reminder, northbound traffic on Main Street from the Bypass to Washington Street is shifted to the west half of the street. Northbound traffic continues one-way north of Washington Street to the temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street.
