

Construction Update for the Week of September 24


Construction crews will continue installing the brick pavers along the sidewalks and parking stalls on the east side of Main Street. The pavers shown below will create a beautiful new walkway and enhance the character of Old Town.





Crews continue replacing stoops in front of businesses on Main Street. New stoops have been built on the east side of Main Street and will soon feature decorative hand railings.

As a reminder, northbound traffic on Main Street from the Bypass to Washington Street is shifted to the west half of the street. Northbound traffic continues one-way north of Washington Street to the temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street.
