


Construction Update for the Week of November 19



Crews will install the brick pavers in the intersection of Main and Washington streets this week. To accomplish the work a new temporary detour was installed to allow traffic to access the north section of Main Street by utilizing Jefferson and Washington street. Additional road work will occur between Washington Street and the bridge as crews prepare to install the new concrete road pavement.

Another exciting project begins this week at the Historic Village Hall Plaza. Crews are beginning the stonework to convert this space into an inviting community gathering space. When complete the plaza will include an outdoor fire place, seating, plant life and walk ways for residents and visitors to enjoy.

Detour Information:

Drivers traveling to businesses on Main Street between Washington Street and Crystal Creek will be detoured from the Bypass to Jefferson and Washington streets. Drivers will then be

allowed to make a left turn onto Main Street to access businesses. This detour is active through November 26.

Drivers wishing to visit businesses along south Main Street can access Main Street between the Bypass and Madison Street. Harrison Street also serves as an alternate route for parking and access.
