

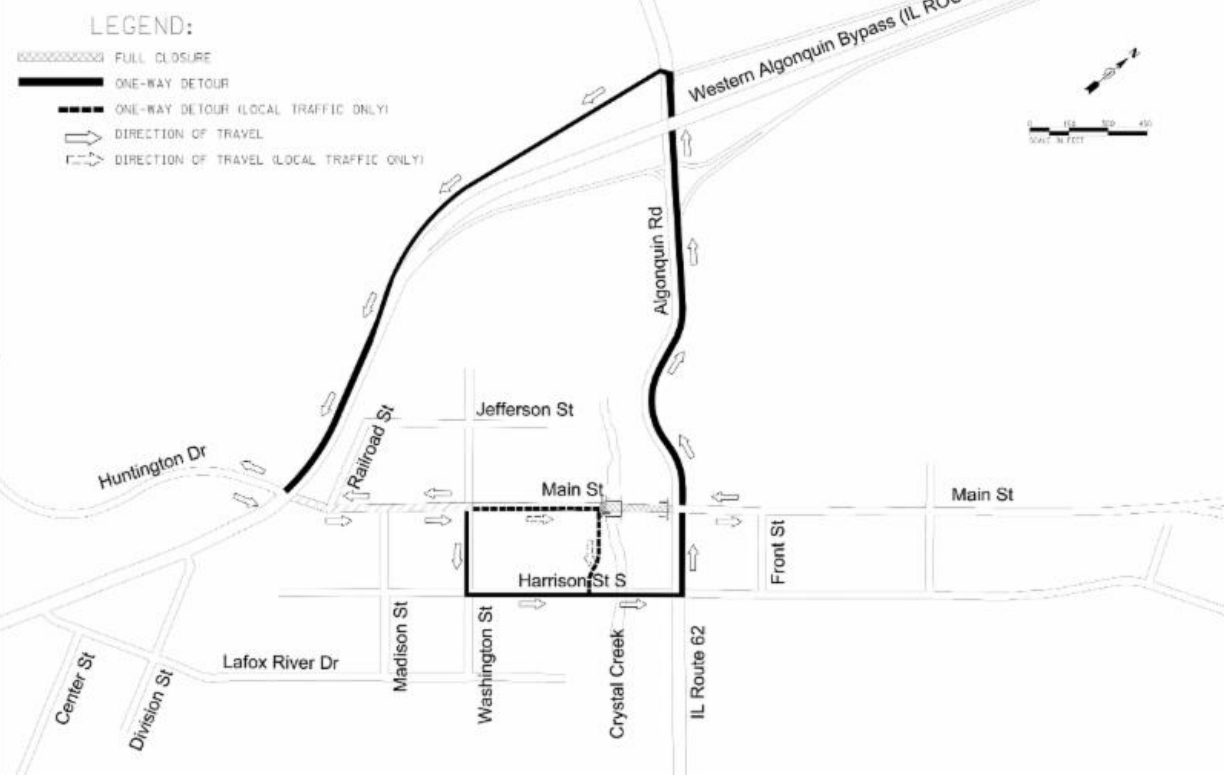


Construction Update for the Week of October 15

On Monday, October 15 traffic will be switched to the east side of Main Street. This lane shift will allow construction crews to safely remove the curb and pavement on the west side of Main Street north of Washington Street. Crews will be removing this infrastructure as the first step in the process of building the base of the sidewalks, curbs and roadway. In the coming weeks, after the base is completed, crews can begin laying the bricks and building the stone seat walls and planters that are seen on the east side of Main Street.



The intersection of Washington and Main streets has been reopened to traffic and drivers can now proceed northbound on Main Street directly from the Bypass.
