



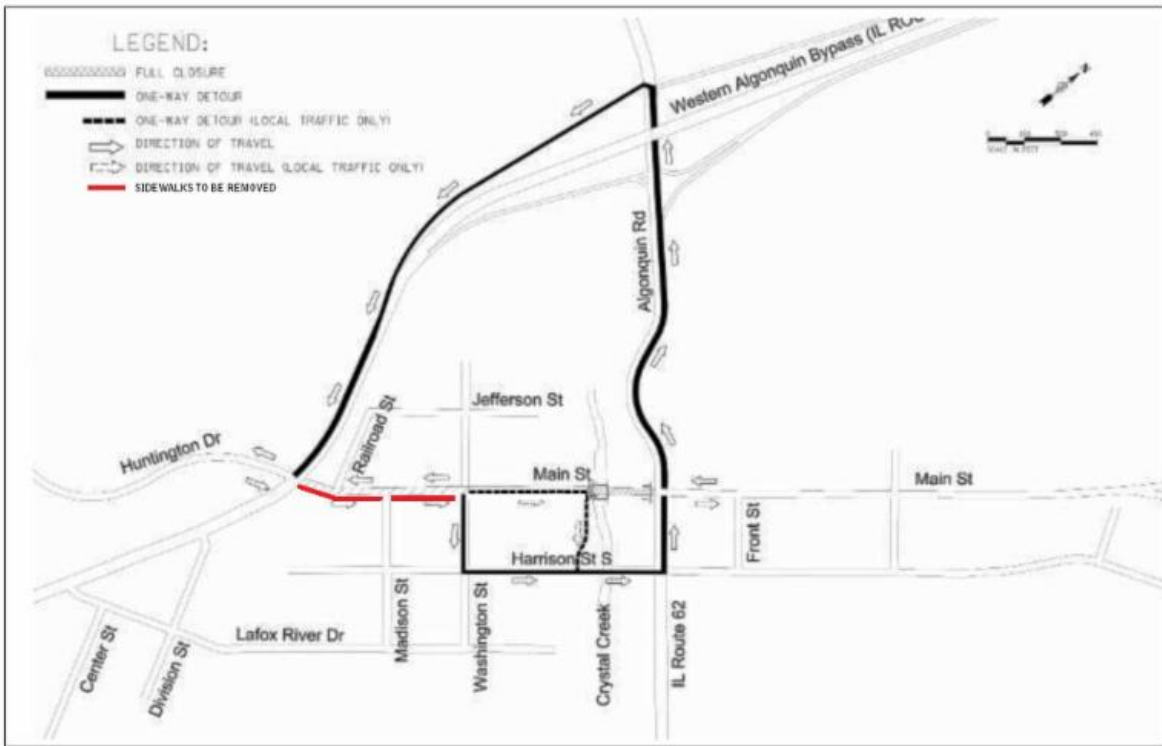
Construction Update for the Week of October 22



Crews worked last week to frame the curb and sidewalks along the west side of Main Street. This work really helps display the future shape of west side of the street. The upcoming week will include placing concrete pavement south of Washington Street. Crews will also be completing the ADA ramps along the sidewalk on the west side of the street.

Construction crews will start adding soil for the tree grates. This step will prepare the west side of the street for the future planting of trees in Old Town.

As a reminder, northbound traffic continues one-way north of Washington Street to the temporary ramp next to Crystal Creek to access Harrison Street. Drivers will experience new pavement on the east side of Main Street north of Washington Street.
