



## Construction Update for the Week of November 26

Construction crews will complete the installation of brick pavers in the intersection of Washington and Main streets this week. This work will be accompanied by the installation of the roadway pavement and brick paver sidewalks south of Washington Street.

Electrical work is also planned at Historic Village Hall Plaza to help create a new gathering place with updated lighting and an outdoor fireplace for the community to enjoy.
