

Construction Update for December 7

This week, AT&T and the project contractor made progress on several items:

- AT&T has been on site installing the top portion of the precast duct over Crystal Creek.
- Crews installed new curbs and brick pavers north of the bridge on the east side of Main Street.
- Crews worked on traffic signals for the northbound traffic lanes.
- The contractor completed pavement striping at the intersection of Main Street and Algonquin Road.



Next week, crews will finish work on the ADA ramp and brick pavers at 103-107 South Main Street.

South Main Street will reopen to two-way traffic on the afternoon of Wednesday, Dec. 11. Expect periodic lane closures over the next two weeks as crews complete miscellaneous items.
