



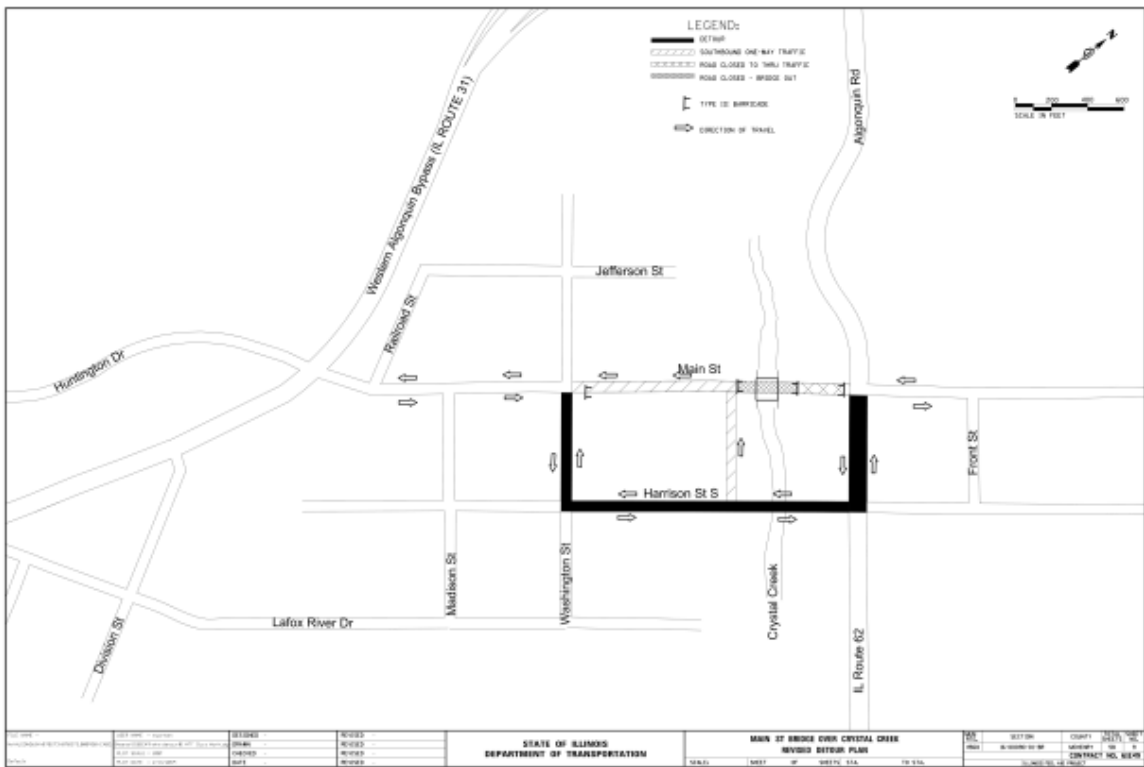
Construction Update for the Week of February 18

The replacement of the Main Street Bridge over Crystal Creek is expected to begin this week. The reconstruction of the bridge will include the upgrading of the infrastructure, including the water main, sanity sewer, storm sewer and lighting. Weather permitting, it is anticipated that this work will take six months to complete. Please note, that construction will be allowed Monday through Saturday from 7 am – 8 pm and on Sundays from 8 am – 8 pm.

A **new Main Street detour** will be implemented to accommodate the bridge removal and replacement. Beginning Monday, access to Main Street south of the bridge will be available via the temporary alley off of Harrison Street for southbound traffic only. Northbound traffic will be detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street. The section of Main Street between Algonquin Road and the bridge over Crystal Creek will be closed to through traffic. This detour route will go into effect Monday and was selected to allow the community to utilize the diagonal parking along S. Main Street.



This traffic detour pattern will remain in effect until the construction of the bridge is complete.
