

Construction Update for the Week of February 4

Phase II Construction to Kick Off

Old Town Algonquin will be starting the next phase of construction with watermain and sanitary sewer improvements on the north section of Main Street. These underground improvements will be made between Algonquin and Cary roads. The Village will be replacing all lead water lines in the area leading up to the property connection points. This will ensure that residents and businesses in Algonquin are receiving safe, clean water.

As the weather improves you will see crews start the process of locating and marking the underground utilities in preparation for this construction phase. More information will be provided about schedules, detours and impacts as this phase of construction begins.

Crystal Creek Bridge Update

Construction crews are also eager to begin the reconstruction of the Main Street Bridge over Crystal Creek. AT&T's crews will begin relocating their fiber that is connecting to the bridge as the temperatures begin to rise. Once this work is complete Old Town construction crews can begin removing and replacing the old structure that carries Main Street traffic over the creek. A construction alert will be issued before the bridge is closed to traffic and work begins.



Detour

The current traffic pattern remains in effect with southbound drivers entering Main Street from Algonquin Road. The bridge over Crystal Creek is open to **one-way southbound** traffic

from Algonquin Road to Washington Street. Two-way traffic is allowed in the section of Main Street between Washington Street and the Bypass. **When bridge and phase II work begins a new detour map will be issued.**
