


## **Construction Update for the Week of March 11**




Crews have made a lot of progress in the removal of the bridge that carries Main Street over Crystal Creek. Workers will continue to remove the steel beams and piers so that a new, safer structure can be built.

Many other elements of the Old Town project have been completed and as the temperatures rise, we encourage visitors to check out:

- New electronic vehicle charging stations
- Brick paver sidewalks and parking stalls
- Beautiful iron railings in front of businesses
- Decorative lighting
- Seat walls with brick accents



The north section of Main Street will also see workers begin the installation of new sanitary sewer infrastructure. This work will begin at the intersection of Front and Main streets and progress north to Riverview Drive.



The current detour remains in place until the construction of Main Street over Cyrstal Creek is complete. Access to Main Street south of the bridge will be available via the temporary alley off of Harrison Street for southbound traffic only. Northbound traffic will be detoured at Washington Street to Harrison Street. The section of Main Street between Algonquin Road and the bridge over Crystal Creek will be closed to through traffic.

Local access will be maintained for the section of Main Street between Algonquin Road and Riverview Drive. All other traffic should follow posted detours and utilize the Bypass.
