

Construction Update for the Week of May 20




This week, drilling will continue for the shaft foundations needed for the bridge over Crystal Creek. This work is labor intensive, as crews are drilling 30 holes for the foundation. Construction of the bridge is anticipated to be completed this summer. Once the bridge structure is finished, a decorative archway will be added welcoming residents and visitors to Old Town.

On Monday, crews will finish installing the lighting at Historic Village Hall Plaza. This work will accent the already completed outdoor fireplace, stage and brick pavers. In the upcoming weeks, crews will complete the plaza with decorative handrails and landscaping. Additional landscaping will also be added on south Main Street.



On the north section of Main Street, crews will be installing the new sanitary sewers on Front Street.
