



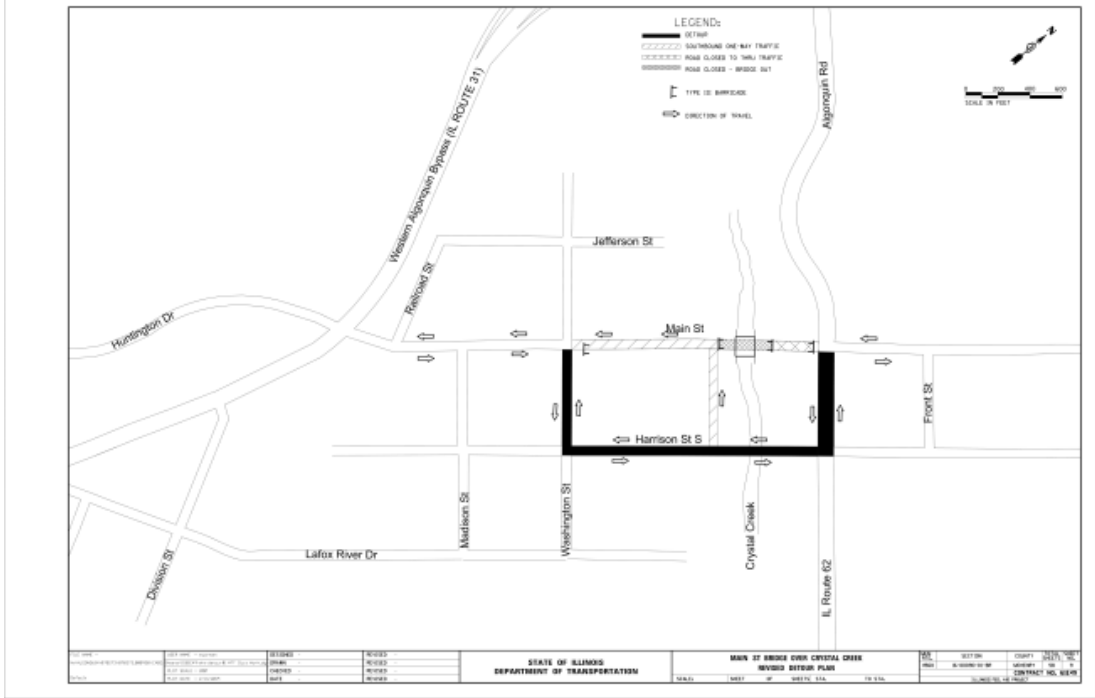
Construction Update for the Week of August 12



Construction crews have completed pouring the first layer of concrete for the bridge deck over Crystal Creek. The second layer of concrete will be poured this week to create the curbs and pedestrian sidewalks. It takes several days for concrete to fully cure or dry. During this time, crews will begin work on the water main infrastructure on the north side of the bridge.

As a reminder, the bridge will reopen to traffic this **fall** after the roadway work is complete. A construction alert will be sent to notify the community when the detour is removed and full traffic operations on Main Street can resume.

As a reminder, the current detour impacting the section of Main Street south of Algonquin Road remains in place during bridge construction.
