

Construction Update for the Week of September 9





Installation of the new pedestrian pergola over Crystal Creek began at the end of the week! This new structure will create an attractive gateway for pedestrians entering downtown Algonquin. The masonry work on the new seat benches and columns around the pedestrian pergola was also completed adding to the old town charm atmosphere.

Crews will continue working this coming week to complete the pedestrian pergola and begin the sidewalk and parkway restoration on north Main Street. On the north side of the bridge, work will also continue on the underground utilities and crews will also begin to construct the roadway connection to the bridge.


Once the sidewalk connections are completed and safe for pedestrians, the bridge will be opened to pedestrian traffic while crews complete the utilities and new streetscape elements being added to Main Street on the north side of the bridge.

The current detour impacting the section of Main Street south of Algonquin Road remains in place during bridge construction. As a reminder, **public parking is available** along Main Street south of the bridge or in the parking lots located behind Bold American Fare Restaurant or at the corner of Harrison and Washington streets. The parking lot located behind Bold American Fare can be accessed directly from IL 62.
