



Construction Update: October 3

Last week, the contractor finished installing the sanitary sewer and the water main along S. Harrison Street between Crystal Creek and Algonquin Road. Crews also began removing and replacing curb, sidewalk and driveways in the construction area and will continue this work in stages for the next several weeks. Access to driveways will be restricted for 7-10 days to allow the concrete to cure, and the contractor will notify impacted residents in advance in person and via door hangers.


S. Harrison Street between Washington Street and Algonquin Road is closed as crews install the sanitary sewer. Starting the week of October 5, the intersection of Washington and S. Harrison streets will also be closed as crews continue installing the sanitary sewer at the intersection and move north along S. Harrison Street. The contractor expects the intersection to reopen at the end of the week.

Note: The parking lots along S. Harrison Street will remain open. Motorists may enter the parking lots through the temporary access ramp installed on Washington Street (see map below).

Detours and Closures

- The intersection of Washington Street and Algonquin Road will be closed the week of October 5.
- S. Harrison Street between Washington Street and Algonquin Road is closed.
- The detour along La Fox River Drive and Washington Street remains in place.
- La Fox River Drive from north of Madison Street to the Fox River is closed.
- Washington Street from La Fox River Drive to south of S. Harrison Street is closed.
