



Construction Update: November 6

This week, crews made the following progress:

- Finished restoration and paving along La Fox River Drive from Cornish Park to Center Street and along Washington Street from La Fox River Drive to S. Main Street.
- Placed the concrete patch for S. Harrison Street from Washington Street to the south side of Crystal Creek Bridge. Note: S Harrison Street will be closed along this area through the beginning of next week while the concrete cures. The closure includes the intersection of Washington and S. Harrison streets. The public parking lots along S. Harrison Street will be accessible from the temporary access ramp on Washington Street.
- Started installing the sanitary sewer along N. Harrison Street, beginning at Algonquin Road and heading north toward Front Street. This work will continue for the next few weeks.
- Continued construction of the new lift station.

Here's what's coming up next week:

- Crews will continue installing the sanitary sewer along N. Harrison Street and constructing the new lift station.
- The contractor expects to finish placing the concrete roadway patch on Washington Street by the middle of the week. Once complete, S. Harrison Street will be open up to Crystal Creek and the public parking lots should be accessed via S Harrison Street.

Detours and Closures

- S. Harrison Street between Washington Street and Algonquin Road is closed. N. Harrison Street from Algonquin Road to Front Street is also closed. All businesses along N. Harrison Street between Front and Edward streets are open and accessible from Edward Street.
- Washington Street is closed between Main Street and La Fox River Drive. However, the intersection at Washington and Harrison streets is open so that residents can access the public parking lot.
- Beginning next week, S. Harrison Street will be closed from the intersection of Washington and Harrison streets to Crystal Creek Bridge.
