Construction Update: July 11



Backfilling around the sanitary sewer

This week, crews installed the sanitary sewer up to Madison Street.

Next week, crews will begin water main work along La Fox River Drive between Center and Madison streets. This work will begin at Center Street and progress north along La Fox River Drive. The contractor expects this work to take a few weeks to complete. While installing the water main, crews will repair various segments of the storm sewer.

Also, the team will continue installing temporary groundwater dewatering wells to prepare for the remaining sanitary sewer installation. These wells will be installed along Washington Street between La Fox River Drive and S. Harrison Street and along S. Harrison Street between Washington Street and Algonquin Road. Roads will remain open while the wells are being installed.



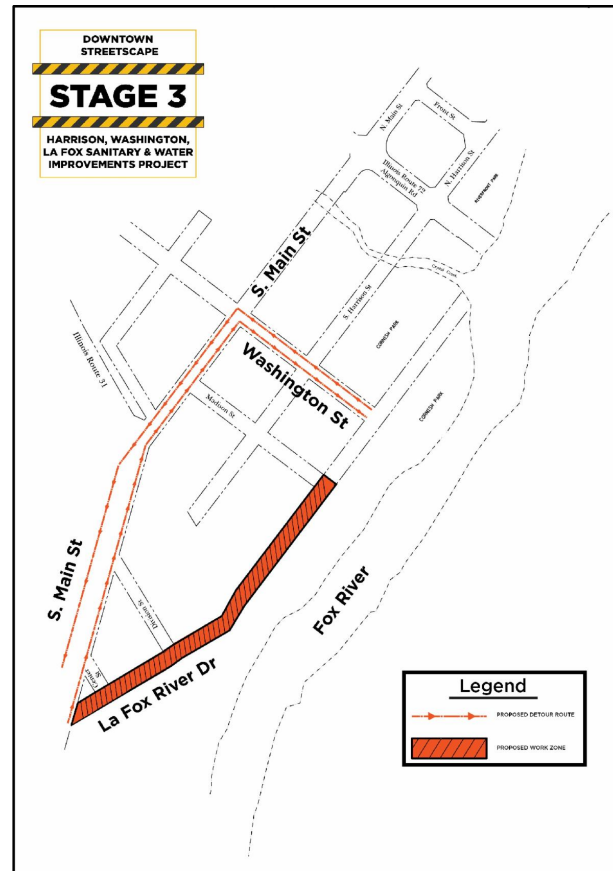
What's Next?

- Crews will install water main between Center Street and Madison Street.
- Once the contractor has tested the water main and put it online, they will transfer water services to the new water main, which includes installing a new water service valve and water line from the property line to the new water main. Residents will be notified 48-hours in advance of any water disruptions.
- As soon as crews complete this work, they expect to begin restoring the roadway.
- By mid-August, the contractor anticipates beginning the work associated with the Crystal Creek Crossing, including installing the sanitary sewer and water main across the creek. Once completed, the contractor will resume installing the sanitary sewer along La Fox River Drive from Madison Street and continue to progress north.

Detour:

Traffic will be routed along Route 31 to Main Street and then back to Washington Street and La Fox River Drive.

We ask that drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists use caution due to the level of construction equipment along La Fox River Drive.



This project is expected to take approximately 10 months to complete. We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we invest in this important infrastructure project to improve the community.
