It only took **one week** for crews to finish installing the sewer and water pipes under Crystal Creek. Did we mention that the construction team worked day and night and literally had to move the creek, building dams and pumping the water (with by-pass equipment) around the work zone? Road/Sidewalk Closure:**
Harrison Street remains closed
between the access points at the

Village-owned parking lots and Rt. 62 until crews clear the work zone.

The work zone along S. Harrison Street is closed to pedestrians as well. Pedestrians and drivers should take Washington Street to Main Street to detour around the construction zone.

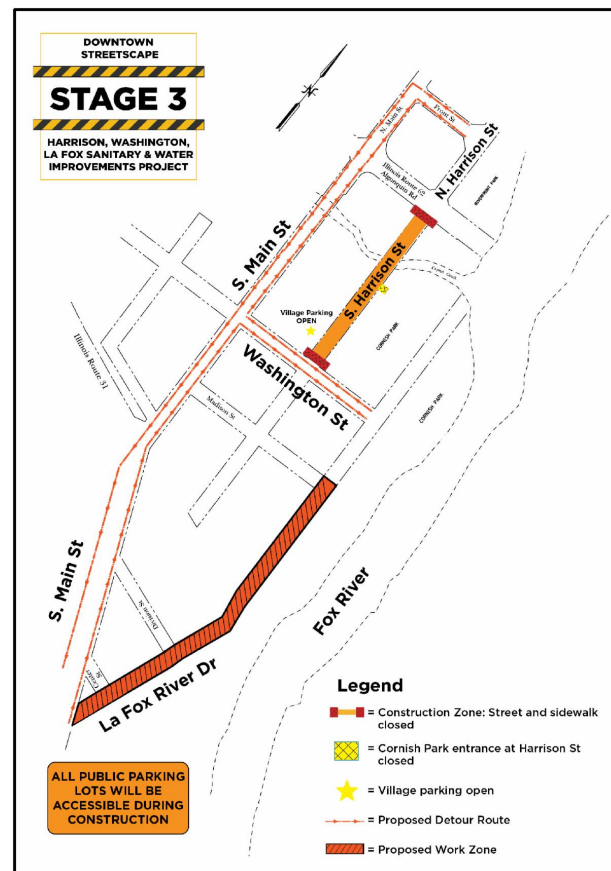


Legend
